SERMON OUTLINE

1. I have been called by God to serve. Exodus 3
2. I have been equipped by God to serve. Exodus 4:1-17
3. I am a servant of the Most High God. Exodus 4:27-31

REVIEW THE PASSAGE

Review Moses' questions and God's responses in Exodus 3:10-12 and Exodus 4:10-17. What were Moses' concerns? What was God's answers? What does this teach us about God's calling in our lives?

God wasn't calling Moses because Moses was great. God was calling Moses because God was great. Where else in Scripture do we see God call people that were less than "qualified" to serve?

ASSESS YOUR LIFE

Have you ever or are you currently serving from of a poor motivation (guilt, earning God's favor, selfish ambition, etc.)? Our motivation for serving is to come from obedience, gratefulness, and following Jesus example. In order to serve from this motivation, what do you need to believe about God and the Gospel?

When you've served others in tangible ways in the past, how has God worked both in you and through you? Where is God using you presently or where is He calling you to serve going forward?

APPLY THE TRUTH

We were challenged to respond in two ways: to have a weekly place for consistent ministry and to wake up each day looking for opportunities to serve God with the people around me. Do you have both? Where is God working around you and how is he calling you to be a part of it?

For the group: Review your group's prayer list. Spend time praying over these things, adding to the list, and reviewing any answers given. How has God begun to answer your group's prayers?
