SERMON OUTLINE

- 1. React with Prayer. Acts 4:23-24
- 2. Rely on God's Plan. Acts 4:25-28
- 3. Refill with God's Faithfulness. Acts 4:29-31

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. Looking back at your notes, is there anything you heard for the first time or something that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. In Acts 4:29 the disciples responded with boldness to being threatened by the authorities. What is the source of their boldness? How can we speak the Gospel with all boldness?
- 3. When the church encountered hardship in Acts 4, their first reaction was to pray. What's typically your first reaction to hardship? What does that say about what you put your trust and hope in?
- 4. How should knowing nothing is a surprise to God and everything is under His control change how we navigate life?
- 5. Practically, what does it look like to refill on the faithfulness of Jesus? What are some things that could prevent you from refilling on the faithfulness of Jesus?

BREAKOUT DISCUSSION

- 1. How are you doing at refilling with God's faithfulness? If it's not going well for you, what is one thing you could do differently this week to better see God's faithfulness?
- 2. Tell the group about someone in your life you've been working towards sharing the Gospel with that they can pray for. If no one comes to mind, share someone in your circle of influence that you can work toward sharing the Gospel with.

PRAYER POINTS

- 1. Pray for boldness to share the Gospel and that God would illuminate people to share the gospel with in our lives.
- 2. Ask God to refill you with his faithfulness and enable you to enter his rest.
- 3. Praise God for being intimately involved in our lives and rejuvenating us to run the race with endurance.
