SERMON OUTLINE

Big Idea: Through godly leadership you can lead others to hope in Christ. Godly leaders lead toward hope in Christ by...

- 1. Bold proclamation, not selfish scamming. 1 Thessalonians 2:1-2
- 2. Faithful stewardship, not misguided priorities. 1 Thessalonians 2:3-4
- 3. Gentle care, not personal gain. 1 Thessalonians 2:5-8
- 4. Blameless conduct, not baseless burden. 1 Thessalonians 2:9-10
- 5. Clear instruction, not unfair expectations. 1 Thessalonians 2:11-12

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. Looking back at your notes, is there anything you heard for the first time or something that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. Starter: Tell us about a great leader you've personally known. What made them a great leader?
- 3. What is boldness? As a believer, why do you need it and what should you do with it?
- 4. The church is sometimes infiltrated by swindlers and shams. What does this passage teach us about how to not become one ourselves?
- 5. What might it look like for you to share not only the gospel, but also your own self? How are you inspired by the example of Christ in Matthew 20:28?

BREAKOUT DISCUSSION

- 1. What's one way this week's passage challenges or encourages you?
- 2. With Paul's description of leadership in mind ("holy and righteous and blameless"), share a success or failure of leadership in your life.
- 3. What might verses 11-12 look like in your life this coming week?

- 2. Pray for the leaders in your life.
- 3. Pray for your own godly leadership qualities to grow.
