SERMON OUTLINE

The Call: We are called to increase in our love for one another.

- 1. Be taught by God. 1 Thessalonians 4:9
- 2. Express love in practical ways. 1 Thessalonians 4:10-11
 - a. More love, less complacency. (10b)
 - b. More prayer, less chatter. (11a)
 - c. More investment, less idleness. (11b)
- 3. Remember the world is watching. 1 Thessalonians 4:12

GROUP DISCUSSION

- 1. Looking back at your notes, is there anything you heard for the first time or something that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. We learn to love others from God. What is God teaching you about loving other believers?
- 3. What does it mean "to aspire to live quietly, and to mind your own affairs"? What's the value of living this kind of life?
- 4. Why are we prone to get in other people's business? What sin needs to be addressed in your heart before you can become a person who lives quietly and minds your own affairs?

BREAKOUT DISCUSSION

- 1. What is one way this passage has challenged or encouraged you?
- 2. In what ways do you feel you're walking properly before outsiders? In what ways are you walking improperly?
- 3. Paul has given commands in this passage concerning sexual immorality, love for fellow Christians, and day-to-day work. What can you do this week to become more obedient in one of these areas?

PRAYER POINTS

- 1. Ask God to help you genuinely grow in love for your brothers and sisters in Christ.
- 2. Pray for fellow believers that you know who are in physical or spiritual need.
- 3. Ask God for opportunity this week to influence "outsiders" with the gospel.
