SERMON OUTLINE

1. I was faithful to everything God called me to. Acts 20:24
2. I told the truth without wavering. Acts 20:25-27
3. I pointed people to Jesus and not myself. Acts 20:28-30
4. I have finished strong. Acts 20:31-32
5. I gave more than I took. Acts 20:33-36

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. Looking back at the passage and your notes, is there anything you heard for the first time or something that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
2. How did you find your spiritual gifts or get involved with serving? What advice would you give someone who hasn't served before or doesn't know their gifting?
3. What is true success or a truly successful ministry? What does that look like in your context not being a full-time pastor but at work, at school, at home, etc.?
4. Which relationships or types of relationships are you tempted to pull punches in? What does it mean to faithfully share the whole counsel of God like Paul in v27 in light of the truth of 1 Corinthians 3:2 and Hebrews 5:12 that some people aren't ready for some teachings?
5. What are some common reasons people don't finish life well? How can we ensure we finish well? In other words, like Paul, we resolved to finish life well, now what do we do right now to ensure we will persevere the rest of our lives?

BREAKOUT DISCUSSION

1. There are 2 common mistakes in ministry: do nothing or very little, or try to do everything. Which are you more inclined to? How? What way do you need to be challenged most?
2. How is it going with that person you're trying to share the Gospel with this year? How can you utilize the coming summer to make progress towards that goal with this person?

PRAYER POINTS

1. Praise God for the 4 Baptism we had here at City on a Hill and the Baptisms at Redemption Church!
2. Pray that above all else we would be found faithful with the opportunities and resources God has given us.
3. Ask God to bless the block party, that many people from the community would come and see the light and love of Jesus.
