## **SERMON OUTLINE**

- 1. Jesus is the triumphant king we need. Luke 19:38
- 2. Jesus is the source of peace we seek. Luke 19:38
- 3. Jesus is worthy of all the worship we bring. Luke 19:38-40

### **GROUP DISCUSSION**

- 1. Looking back at the passage and your notes, is there anything you heard for the first time or something that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. Check for understanding: What statement was Jesus making by riding into Jerusalem on a colt that has never been ridden?
- 3. What about Jesus our triumphant king excites you (or should excite you)? Where in our culture do you see the need/desire (even if they wouldn't say it) for a perfect king?
- 4. How does Jesus bring us peace despite our circumstances? How do we get that peace? What other things do we try to find our peace in or add to the peace?
- 5. Define this "peace" we can only find in Jesus we just talked about. Be really specific. Is it a particular feeling? Different from enjoyment and pleasure? An absence of fear, anxiety, and worry? A particular life situation or circumstance?

## **BREAKOUT DISCUSSION**

- 1. How have you been preparing your heart for Easter Sunday? Are you planning on being there for Friday and Sunday?
- 2. Worshipping Jesus isn't just for Sunday or for Holy Week, but ideally, should be a 24/7 pursuit. Thinking through the past couple of weeks, how often outside Sunday are you thinking about and actually worshipping?

### **PRAYER POINTS**

- 1. Praise God for our king who came to conquer sin and death!
- 2. Pray that God would prepare our hearts to remember good Friday and Easter Sunday.
- 3. Ask God to see and rest in the peace that can only be found in Jesus.
