	P DISCUSSION Looking back at the passage and your notes, what truth was most encouraging to you and why?
2.	Discuss the role of prayer in drawing near to God. How does prayer help us connect with God and experience His grace and mercy?
3.	In what ways can we encourage one another to draw near to God? How can we create a supportive community that fosters a deeper relationship with Him?
4.	Reflect on the statement, "Drawing near to God is not just about what we can receive from Him but also about cultivating a deeper relationship with Him." What does it look like to balance our desires for help and provision with the desire to grow closer to God?
5.	How does drawing near to Jesus and His throne of grace affect our perspective on challenges and trials we face? Share an example of how drawing near to God has brought comfort and strength during a difficult time.
