SERMON OUTLINE

1. Our caring King. Hebrews 2:5-9
2. Our conquering Hero. Hebrews 2:10
3. Our loving Brother. Hebrews 2:11-16
4. Our understanding Priest. Hebrews 2:17-18

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. Looking back at the passage and your notes, what encouraged you or stood out to you?
2. Check for understanding: What does it mean in v10 when it says "make the founder of their salvation perfect through suffering"?
3. Which picture of Jesus most speaks to you in this season of life? Why?
4. Share some other passages of Scripture that speak to how God is close to us, cares for each of us, and is intimately involved in each of our lives.
5. Why does God sometimes feel far off? How does this passage combat that idea? Is God ever closer to or farther from us? Give support for your answer.

BREAKOUT DISCUSSION

1. How can Jesus' empathy and compassion help us in our weakness and temptation? Give a specific example from your life where it could apply.
2. What would it look like for us to hold each other accountable to and to help another trust in Jesus our caring king during difficult times?
