- **55** Give ear to my prayer, O God, and hide not yourself from my plea for mercy!
- ² Attend to me, and answer me;
 I am restless in my complaint and I moan,

 ³ because of the noise of the enemy,
 because of the oppression of the wicked.

 For they drop trouble upon me,
 and in anger they bear a grudge against me.
- ⁴My heart is in anguish within me; the terrors of death have fallen upon me.
- ⁵ Fear and trembling come upon me, and horror overwhelms me.
- ⁶ And I say, "Oh, that I had wings like a dove! I would fly away and be at rest;
- ⁷yes, I would wander far away;I would lodge in the wilderness; Selah
- *I would hurry to find a shelter from the raging wind and tempest."
- ⁹ Destroy, O Lord, divide their tongues; for I see violence and strife in the city.
- ¹⁰ Day and night they go around it on its walls,
- and iniquity and trouble are within it;
- ¹¹ ruin is in its midst;
- oppression and fraud
- do not depart from its marketplace.
- ¹² For it is not an enemy who taunts me then I could bear it;
- it is not an adversary who deals insolently with me
 - then I could hide from him.
- ¹³But it is you, a man, my equal, my companion, my familiar friend.
- ¹⁴We used to take sweet counsel together;

- within God's house we walked in the throng.
- ¹⁵ Let death steal over them; let them go down to Sheol alive; for evil is in their dwelling place and in their heart.
- ¹⁶ But I call to God, and the Lord will save me.
- ¹⁷ Evening and morning and at noon I utter my complaint and moan, and he hears my voice.
- ¹⁸ He redeems my soul in safety from the battle that I wage, for many are arrayed against me.
- ¹⁹ God will give ear and humble them, he who is enthroned from of old, Selah because they do not change and do not fear God.
- ²⁰ My companion¹⁰ stretched out his hand against his friends;
 - he violated his covenant.
- ²¹His speech was smooth as butter, yet war was in his heart; his words were softer than oil, yet they were drawn swords.
- ²² Cast your burden on the Lord, and he will sustain you; he will never permit the righteous to be moved.
- But you, O God, will cast them down into the pit of destruction;
 men of blood and treachery shall not live out half their days.
 But I will trust in you.
